The Great Evacuation

An invitation sent by the Sécurité publique du Québec, asking all families to evacuate their house on the same day, at the same time.

The Great Evacuation took place on Wednesday, October 10th, at 6 pm, in all the streets of the province of Quebec. All citizens were strongly encouraged to participate in this activity. Families were asked to test their smoke detectors and practice their escape plan all on the same day, at the same time, by evacuating their house and meeting at predetermined locations. All in the name of safety, of course.

Since when does the State worry so much about protection and prevention? Since when do they decide, on the brink of financial collapse, to invest millions of dollars into a province-wide multi-media blitz simply meant as a preventive practice in case of fire? There must be a hidden reason that we will now attempt to discover.

All in The Name of Safety

The last time politicians put so much paternalistic pressure on Quebecers was during the H1N1 pandemic, an outright lie from the World Health Organization. On that occasion, Quebec invested 146 million dollars and succeeded in getting 57 % of its population vaccinated – the highest ratio on the planet! The Quebecers who complied were injected with a poisonous mixture made up of non-divulged ingredients with a hidden list of short- and long-term effects. Of course, this was all done in the name of safety, once again.

A similar type of pressure was put on Quebecers in the weeks preceding *The Great Evacuation*. Did our Holy Father the State think that its citizens were too stupid to figure out how to get out of a house on fire? Why did they insist so much on extending this practice to the whole province at the same time? Something is wrong.

The Sécurité publique du Québec suddenly claimed that fire prevention was of primary importance and spent much time, money, and effort to make sure that as many citizens as possible participated in this province-wide event. State officials embarked on a thoroughly orchestrated propaganda campaign: various types of promotional material, huge media coverage, participation of large numbers of firefighters and policemen, numerous warnings to car drivers to watch for children during the event, extensive poster campaign in family-oriented buildings (restaurants, libraries, stores, cinemas, etc.), attractive written and video information freely distributed to day-care centres and primary schools, etc. The underlying message seemed clear: “Everybody outside, gather in groups, get in line, climb on the bus. We are taking you away.”

In Politics, Nothing Happens by Accident

This plan was probably concocted a long time ago. “In politics, nothing happens by accident. If it happens, ⇒

you can bet it was planned that way.” (F.D. Roosevelt) Do you know that, according to a 2009 province-side survey, firefighters are considered by the general population to be the trust-worthiest of all role players? The question asked during the survey was: “Do you trust or not a person exercising the following occupation: acupuncturist, chiropractor, economist, electrician, firefighter, insurance salesman, mailman, medical doctor, new-car salesman, notary, nurse, plumber, politician, priest, publicist, surveyor, trade unionist, teacher, used-car salesman, and veterinarian?” The results were fascinating. Firemen got the highest score, with 96 % YES. The lowest score was given to used-car salesmen (4 %) and the second lowest to politicians (6 %).

Surprise, surprise! In 2011, Quebec’s firefighters started inspecting Quebec homes, insisting on coming inside and taking pictures and notes on house disposition, the location of doors and windows, etc. They also encouraged families to make an evacuation plan. Some citizens became suspicious and refused them entry. In such a case, firemen went as far as threatening homeowners with police intervention or heavy fines, while they repeated parrot-fashion: “We are doing this for your own safety.” Simultaneously, there was and still is an intensive province-wide billposting along Quebec’s roads. What lies hidden behind such shady initiatives?

Predictive Programming

Such initiatives are typical of what is called “predictive programming”, a subtle form of psychological conditioning to acquaint the public with planned social changes to be implemented in the near future. When these changes are later carried out, the public has already been familiarized with them and accepts them as a natural progression. This is the most efficient way to lessen any possible public resistance and commotion. Such programming takes place through the repetition of usually uncommon concepts, images, experiences, behaviours, or circumstances. The population gradually gets used to them and ends up finding them normal and acceptable. When the time comes, citizens automatically act in the manner in which they have been programmed. **When the time comes for what?**

The next obvious question concerning *The Great Evacuation* is: What have the authorities planned that demands an evacuation and a relocation of the whole population?

What Personocratia* Thinks and Does
